Hulhumale Hospital Mental Health Center aims to provide quality mental health care and caters for patients. Our services include diagnosis and medication by psychiatrists along with various therapies and assessments by psychologists and counselors. Our objective is to raise mental health awareness in the community and challenge stigma and discrimination associated with mental illness.

Operating in collaboration with Cadabams Group of Health Care, India, our Mental Health Centre benefits from their expertise spanning more than two decades in the field of mental healthcare. Presently, our team includes of one psychiatrist and two psychologists from Cadabams.

Our Focus

- To provide early intervention for children exhibiting signs of mental stress and prodrome of mental illnesses to prevent onset or delay and decrease the intensity of subsequent symptoms.
- To provide the individual, households, schools, work places and general community information on healthy lifestyles and coping strategies for resilience
- To provide multidisciplinary services to promote mental wellbeing, teach techniques to cope with the stresses of life, learn and work well, and contribute positively to their community
- To minimize institutionalization and promote community integration and inclusion and help individuals live life to the best of their abilities.
- Mental health services for elderly people, to optimize their quality of life
- Give special consideration to children under state care and prioritize their mental health care
- Online consultation of Psychiatrist and Psychologist for patients residing outside greater Male'
- Engaging in continuous education, research activates to advance our understanding of mental health disorders, treatment outcomes, and best practices in mental healthcare delivery
- Provide internship opportunities for students completing their psychology and counselling education
